2. What village can you see across the valley?	Along Summerfield Terrace	Swainswick or Bailbrook
3. ??? Terrace	Summerfield Terrace	Summerfield Terrace (to the left before you turn right)
4. How many steps	32	Going down towards Perfect View
5. How many houses have the perfect view?	2 (or total of 17)	Perfect View Terrace but only 2 houses have the name on their house.
6. How many dogs can you see & what's the fine for failing to clear up?	2 & £1000	By entrance to walk after Perfect View Terrace
7. What's the total of gate numbers?	88	Along drive by Beacon Wood Hs.
8. Draw the sign of falling rocks		At entrance to drive above
9. How many churches can you see?	5	Path/road going upwards (St Stephen's Rd)
10. You must know which church this is?	St Stephen's	Junction of path to left at St Stephen's Road/Camden Row
11. Can you see the bench mark? Look low down on the wall and draw it		On wall to right as you go down steep path at head of Camden Row
12. Find the ecclesiastical brewery	Abbey Ales	At foot of Camden Row
13. What was rebuilt in 1892?	Old Farm House pub	Going up Lansdown Road
14. What is DP 621?	Telegraphy pole	by No 3 Lansdown Terrace
15. What's missing from Faith, ?? and Charity?	Hope	Hope Place
16. What was the ironwork item attached to the wall by no 2 used for?	Snuffer for Georgian flame	2 Lansdown Crescent
17. What does the symbol mean to the top right of No 5	Insurance plaque	5 Lansdown Crescent

18. Who lived at No 20?	William Beckford	20 Lansdown Crescent
19. Who is watching you from nos 10 & 11	Stone work face outlines	Above the doors of nos 10/11 Somerset Place
20. Can you see some new houses? What happened to the old ones	Bombed in the 1942 blitz	End of Somerset Place
21. Count the steps again	58	Steps leading down to junctions of Cavendish Road/Sion Road/Winifred Rd
22. Where is it against the law to smoke on private premises?	Phone box	At foot of Winifred's Lane/Sion Hill
22. Whose is the well?	St Winifred's	His name at entrance to Somerset Lane
23. What does the wise old owl tell?	Owl on weather vane	10 Sion Rd
24. When was the turnpike put here?	1835	Turnpike Trust on Lansdown Rd
25. What's wrong with this castle?	Only has a tower and nothing else – Beckford's Castle	Beckford's Castle (?) set back on right side of Lansdown Rd by new build/renovated apartments
26. How is St Stephen described on the exterior of the church?	"full of faith & power"	On a plaque at the rear of church (by flower beds)
